Planning a remodeling project? Let us work with you and your contractor to help with deconstruction of your quality materials* that can be reused. Habitat ReStore staff will facilitate your deconstruction donation, with labor provided by either your contractor or others that we know and trust. Your donated items will then be sold through Omaha's Habitat ReStore with the proceeds going to build more Habitat homes in our community.

*Quality materials can include: cabinets, appliances, fixtures, doors, windows, furniture, sinks, etc.

Benefits to the Donor

- It's free! Your donated materials may also be eligible for a tax deduction (contact your accountant with questions)
- Helps the environment by keeping quality items out of the landfill
- Proceeds from your donated items help build decent, affordable homes in our community

How it Works

1. Call Omaha's Habitat ReStore at (402) 884-6976 to schedule a deconstruction assessment
2. Habitat ReStore Deconstruction staff will visit your house/project to assess and itemize salvageable items
3. The deconstruction day(s) will be scheduled to fit your needs
4. Habitat ReStore will pick up the deconstructed materials
5. The subcontractor will charge Habitat ReStore for their labor costs
6. Habitat ReStore encourages the client to make an optional financial donation to help offset the labor cost in order to help us create a sustainable program
7. Habitat ReStore will provide the client with an itemized receipt listing donated items**
8. Client has the satisfaction of knowing they are keeping good materials from the landfill and that all materials will be sold through Habitat ReStore in order to help Habitat build more homes in Omaha!

**It is the client's responsibility to assess a value on donated items for tax purposes. Habitat ReStore recommends that the client seek advice from their accountant or get an appraisal if the value is more than \$5,000.
